Participants will be provided with data examining public information campaigns as a strategy of border enforcement and transnational migration and border enforcement in the US and Australia. A series of skills building workshops will provide participants with an opportunity to learn from and with feminist geographers, cartographers, and designers as we think through how we might use visual technologies to challenge narrow conceptualizations of where enforcement takes place and the mechanism used to govern transnational mobility.
